Purpose/Circumstances

The purpose of this amendment is to remove the classes and sub-classes that the State Services Commission (SSC) were responsible for under the Central Agencies Shared Services (CASS) arrangement (CASS MOU).

After a consultation process with Treasury the SSC has withdrawn from the Central Agencies Shared Service (CASS) Supply Agreement. The withdrawal from the Information Management Services agreement was effective from 1 October 2018. SSC will now take ongoing responsibility for managing their information and records and the ongoing implementation of disposal and transfer.

As SSC is no longer a part of the CASS arrangement, it is necessary to remove those identified classes and sub-classes from the current disposal schedule DA582.

Description of Amendment

The proposed amendments to the DA are to:

- Remove SSC from the Agency (for approval to dispose) column in the current disposal schedule as they are no longer a part of the CASS arrangement (CASS MOU).
- Remove Class 10 Departmental Performance Investigations, this is an SSC only function that is not performed by the other two agencies.
- Remove *Class 11 Administration of Cabinet Fees Framework*, this is an SSC only function that is not performed by the other two agencies.
- Remove Class 12 Consultation and Advice over Collective Employment Agreement, this is an SSC only function that is not performed by the other two agencies.
- Remove Sub-classes 13.1, 13.2, 13.3, 13.4, 13.5, 13.6, 13.7, 13.8, 13.9 from the *Promotion and Development of Capability of State Sector* class, as these are SSC specific classes.
- Change the Agency (for approval to dispose) column for Sub-Classes 13.10, 13.11, 13.12, 13.13 to Treasury as these functions were transferred to Treasury in 2013.
- Remove *Sub-Classes 14.1, 14.2, 14.3, 14.4, 14.5, 14.6,* from the *Appointment and Employment* class, as these are SSC specific classes. Sub-Classes *14.7, 14.8, 14.9, 14.10,* will remain in the disposal schedule as these are sub-classes that Treasury are responsible for.
- Remove Class 15 Develop and Promote Workforce and Employment Policies and Standards, this is an SSC only function that is not performed by the other two agencies.
- Remove Class 16 State Sector Retirement Savings Scheme Administration (SSRSS), this is an SSC only function that is not performed by the other two agencies.
